President's Report

As you have come to expect, the Fall newsletter presents the next year's budget, and I'll try to give you an overview of our association's financial health. We start with the annual maintenance fee, \$310; no increase for the 5th year in a row. We've been careful with our spending, our maintenance fee collection rate has improved, and fortunately, some of our budgeted expenses didn't develop, so we expect to carry about \$50,000 of unspent 2013 funds into 2014. Our Reserves are in really good shape. You'll notice several items as fully funded; therefore, we can reduce our allocations there by over 12%. One item of increased spending for 2014 is our Davis Blvd. entrance, the "front door" of King's Lake. A Board committee will explore refurbishing the wall and its pillars, the two large monuments that background our King's Lake signs, and the necessary landscaping. The Board of Directors will adopt the 2014 budget at its regular meeting on Monday, November 11, 2013 at 7:00 p.m. at the East Naples Firehouse on Davis Blvd. As always, owners are invited to attend.

On the subject of our entranceway, the maintenance crew has been pruning the tops and sides of the Viburnum hedge that frames King's Way and King's Blvd. We hope for more leaves, less wood, and a denser wall with longer plant life. The fall flowers will be planted as soon as "our" fall of less rain, heat, and humidity arrives.



The Board and the community lost a Director and great guy, with the passing of Jim Richardson last spring. We miss his wit and insightful wisdom at our monthly meetings. Tim Owens will finish Jim's term. Bob DiPesa

joined the Board after Marc Cohn resigned.

The Publix construction and shopping center renovation is moving along. Most shops and restaurants are still open and are looking for and do appreciate your patronage.

Thank you for the confidence you have placed in your Board of Directors and we hope you and your family enjoy the Fall and Winter seasons.

Kings Lake Improvements

The Board of Directors strives to keep property values at the highest level. The Board is proactive in making sure our community maintained, replaced amenities are improved. Over the past year we have completed the following projects: resurfacing of the asphalt path around the north lake, including 3 access paths from Kings Lake Blvd.; new landscape improvements along the west lake access path; and new plant installation and major pruning of the Viburnum hedge at the entrance and along west Kings Lake Blvd.

Upcoming projects include renovations at the Kings Lake entrance and Davis Blvd. wall painting and landscaping.

LAKES

Recently a Swedish built weed harvesting machine/boat operated by FloridAquatic Lake Management was deployed on Prince Lake (our shallow middle lake). It effectively removed tons of weeds and grasses, and deposited the material along the shoreline to help restore and stabilize the lake bank. Please visit the Kings Lake website "Photo Album" to view photos of this operation.

The beemat experiment has been terminated for now, and a replacement aeration system will be installed in Prince Lake by our maintenance team.

Permits from the Southwest Water Management District have been requested for additional weed eating Triploid Carp and chemical treatments are overseen and applied by Ecological Control and Management, Inc. of Fort. Myers.

Again, we remind everyone not to fertilize lawns within 10 feet of our lakes per Collier County ordinance. Also, do not use chemicals such as "Roundup" to edge property along the lake bank. This causes destructive erosion. Use String Trimmers only. Please instruct lawn service personnel, if applicable.



Mailboxes & Post Lights

The maintenance and replacement of mailboxes and post lights is the homeowners' responsibility. There are a number of mailboxes and post lights that are in need of repair. The Association maintains an inventory of replacement parts and sells these parts to homeowners at cost. If you need replacements or parts, call Gerald Batten at (239) 775-4487.

Tennis Court Keys

The tennis court is for King's Lake residents and is accessible through a locked gate. You must have a tennis



court key to access the tennis court. You may obtain a key by contacting Gerald Batten at 775-4487. Proof of King's Lake ownership and a \$5.00 deposit are required.

RULES & REGULATIONS REMINDER

Please be aware of the following covenants and rules for all residents of King's Lake:

- Fences and satellite dish antennas are permitted but must be approved by the Association <u>prior</u> to installation.
- Trash cans, recycle bins, and landscape debris should be placed at curbside no earlier than 6:00 p.m. the day before pickup. Please remove your cans and bins from the curb the same day as the pickup day. This is a Collier County ordinance. Cans and bins must be stored in garages or places not visible from the street (other than pick-up days)
- All ADDITIONS and RENOVATIONS to existing homes must be approved by the Association **prior** to commencement of work.
- COMMERCIAL VEHICLES, BOATS, TRAILERS
 AND RECREATIONAL VEHICLES (campers) may
 not be stored or parked within King's Lake except in an
 enclosed garage.
- **Please keep your garage door closed**, except when vehicles are entering or exiting.

These rules keep property values at their highest level!

SIGNS

Please be advised there is an official sign policy, approved by the Board of Directors (after consultation from local real estate agents) for real estate signs. If you wish to place a 'For Sale' sign on your property, the King's Lake Homeowners Association allows one (1) 12" x 18" single-faced sign to be placed in front of your home, not less than 15' behind the street curb. This is the same regulation as adopted by the City of Naples. No other signs are permitted.

'Open House' signs may be placed by the directional sign at the corner of King's Way and King's Lake Blvd. No signs are allowed at the King's Lake entrance at Davis Blvd.

'Garage Sale' signs are not to be taped or otherwise attached to our street signs, lamp posts, speed limit signs or directional signs.



Nature Trail

If you are new to King's Lake, check out our nature trail, located in the

nature preserve near our tennis court on Buckingham Lane. A woodchip trail winds through the woods in a pristine area full of birds and wildlife. The nature trail is open daily during daylight hours.
